Introducing the latest innovation in American Cornhole tournament play: the Round Robin format. This format is ideal for qualifying rounds that move the best teams into a Bracket Challenge. That's why most ACO-sanctioned tournaments have adopted it.

The Round Robin is ideal because it:

- Is easier to schedule. You know ahead of time how long each round should take.
- Makes competition more interesting and fair.
- Gives players a chance to play more - and that's what it's all about.

Running a Round Robin

This chart shows key schedules for an ACO Round Robin. First, divide teams evenly into zones. Second, assign teams (or draw for) random numbers within each zone. Third, find the schedule that matches the number of teams in each zone. For example, if you have 32 teams divided into 4 zones of 8 teams each, you'd use the Round Robin schedule setup for 8 teams.

The chart also tells you how much equipment you'll need and about how long your Round Robin should take.

The Round Robin format is just one way ACO helps you run rocking leagues and tournaments.
